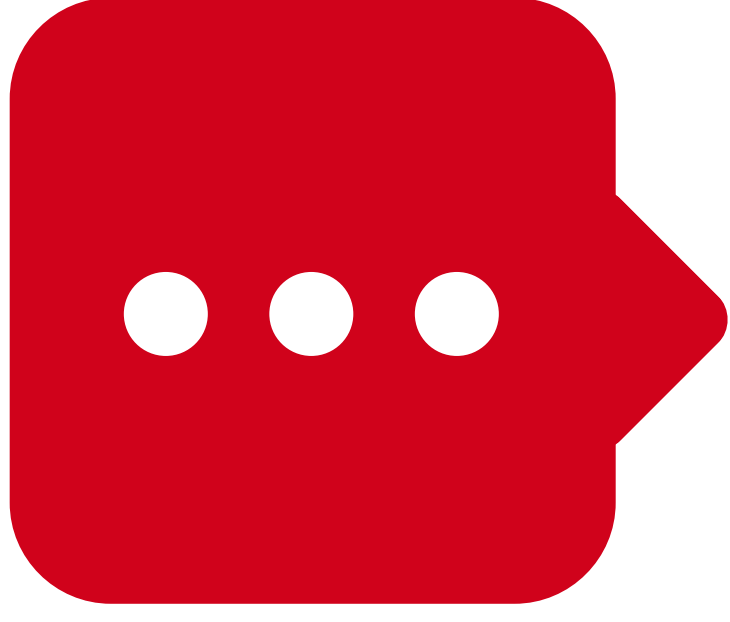


Precinct Chair Spotlight

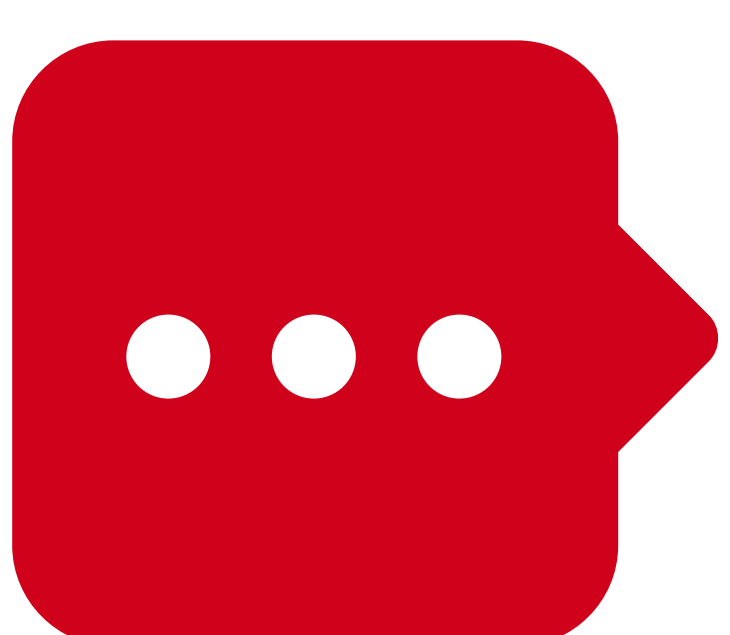
